On **Maundy Thursday**, <u>March 28</u>, we will worship at **6:30 pm**. Our students who have been preparing for first communion will also be partaking this evening in a special celebration.

On **Good Friday**, <u>March 29</u>, we will offer two opportunities to worship at <u>noon</u> and <u>6:30 pm</u>. This will be a Tenebrae service, focusing on Jesus as He is denied all the way to the Cross, where He will die for our sins. Our Men's Ensemble will be leading music at this service.

On **Easter Sunday**, <u>March 31</u>, join us for worship either at <u>7:00 am</u> for a Sunrise service or at <u>10:00</u> <u>am</u> to worship our Risen Savior! Please note that there will be NO Sunday School or Confirmation Classes; and NO Fellowship following either Service on Easter Sunday.

God's Word is Powerful and Sufficient

"The one who has the bride is the bridegroom. The friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices greatly at the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is now complete. He must increase, but I must decrease." (John 3:29-30)

There are some weddings that you can't help but be so excited for. Maybe it's your son or daughter. Maybe it's two close friends you've known for years. Maybe it's one of your parents finding love again. There are some weddings that top all the others, and your joy and excitement is skyrocketing in anticipation of the event.

While we know that it's a day all about the bride (because we all know she looks absolutely stunning!), it takes more than her to make the wedding happen. A certain someone's gotta be there – yup, you guessed it: the groom! Without the groom, the bride is simply a woman dressed in a beautiful gown that she spent a bunch of money on. He is the one who makes the wedding occur. Jesus is the one who stands at the front of the sanctuary eagerly anticipating His bride to come be joined to Him. And we, the Church, are His bride. Jesus sees us coming toward Him and He is eager for us to be with Him. His sight is filled with joy and it seeps into us.
That joy spreads to this world.

The bridegroom is looking at us, seeing His beautiful and stunning bride! He doesn't see our mistakes or our mess-ups; He doesn't see our sin; He sees His beloved.

Walk toward Him today! Be joined to Him. Let His joy be our joy! And as we are filled with joy, let the greatness of His goodness fill our worlds with the sight of our union with Him.

Lord Jesus, it's all about you! You make a relationship with you a reality! You are our joy. Fill us with that joy so we may spread it to this world, captivating them in worship and awe of who you are! Amen.
